What is the Community Connection Program? G2M Community Connection provides the extension to the Summer Learning morning program. It **completes** the full day of learning opportunities for our students at the elementary summer learning sites. These programs are offered in partnership with our "Community Partners" such as 4-H, Boys and Girls Club, Marathon County Parks and Recreation Department, Monk Botanical Gardens and many more! Community Partners rotate throughout the sites. The programs begin at 1:00 PM after students have a FREE lunch, with the program concluding at 4:00 PM. There is no busing available after our program. You will need to make arrangements to pick up your student. This program is designed as a 6 week comprehensive package and is not intended for those seeking a limited number of days and/or weeks. In order to participate, students must enroll in the daytime Summer Learning Program.

How does the registration and payment process work? Students register and pay through their **on-line portal of Infinite Campus**. If the number of students registering exceeds the space available, a lottery drawing will be conducted. Each site can serve 60 students. Siblings of registered students will be kept together for the lottery. Once slots have been filled, students will be placed on a waiting list. To secure your place, payment at time of registration is **strongly** encouraged.

How will students be notified of acceptance into Community Connections? Students will be notified of acceptance into Community Connections with a letter home by May 16, 2022. To secure your space, **payment must be received by April 15, 2022**. If you have not received any information, please contact the G2M Community Connections office at 715-261-0580.

What is the cost of Community Connection? The cost for Community Connection is \$40 per student; however, if enrolling three or more children per family, the maximum fee is \$100. For students economically disadvantaged, the reduced cost is \$10 per student. If you register and pay online and do not receive a slot in a program, your credit or debit card will automatically be refunded. If you are unable to pay online, **payment must be received by April 15, 2022**, to be included in the lottery. If you do not receive a slot, you will receive a refund after July 15, 2022. Online registration and payment are preferred and we are most willing to assist you in this process.

HOW TO REGISTER:

- If you register online, please note if you register for an AM course, it must read 50% complete when you are done. If you register for the AM and PM course, it must read 100% complete when you are done.
- Complete the paper registration form (reverse side) and return with payment to your child's school or mail to:

- Registration deadline to hold or secure your spot by **April 15, 2022**, and look for confirmation of slot by May 16, 2021. When registering online, please note if you register for an AM course, it must read 33% complete when you are done. If you register for an AM and PM course, it must read 67% complete when you are done. If you register for AM, PM and Week 7 it will say 100%.
