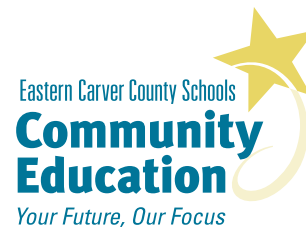

Summer Club Care

Entering grades 1-5

Fun-filled summer days are on the way! Club Care curriculum is developed based on the needs and interests of students and with the philosophy that learning is a year-round process.

As updated COVID guidelines allow, fieldtrips will be scheduled throughout the summer. We will bring in on-site special guests, also. Fieldtrips are attended by all children present that day. All staff attend field trips. The field trip/site activity costs are included in tuition and each child receives a t-shirt to be worn on field trip days. Additional shirts may be purchased for \$10 each at the time of registration.

Summer PULSE

Entering grades 5-8

THE PULSE is designed to meet the needs of middle school students as they grow into responsible teens. At times, young people will be outside of the direct supervision of adults with clear expectations about appropriate boundaries and rules. This will apply to certain times on site as well as field trips throughout the summer. Abuse of rules, check-in times, and set parameters will result in loss of privileges. Attention to the needs of young teens and pre-teens will be given and, at times, different age groups will have different boundaries in terms of supervision.

Participants of THE PULSE will have the opportunity to go on field trips throughout the summer. A schedule will be available by early April. In addition to the scheduled trips, THE PULSE may add impromptu trips as decided by the participants, as a bus is available daily. Ideas will be generated by participants and could include an afternoon movie on rainy days, trips to Dairy Queen, local parks, etc.

THE PULSE families pick their days of attendance for the summer; calendar due by 4/15. Because of this, there are no allotted vacation requests after 4/15.

Vacation Time

Vacation days are allotted based on the number of days per week you are registered. If you are registered 5 days per week, you will receive 5 vacation days, 4 days per week and you will receive 4 vacation days, etc. Once the allotted days have been used, payment is required for any additional absences. ***Vacation days do not apply to The PULSE participants as you already pick your calendar for the summer.***

Meals

A light breakfast and an afternoon snack are provided daily. Families must provide a bag lunch and beverage daily.



Registration Opens February 23! Summer registration opens on-line for **ALL FAMILIES** February 23 at 8:00 a.m. A non-refundable registration fee of \$35 is due at the time of registration.

The **week of February 23- March 2** we will review and process registrations of families currently enrolled in the full day preschool and/or Club Care programs. Beginning March 3 we will review and process other registration requests based on the order received and space availability at desired site, until full.
