Core Curriculum

Seventh grade students are able to choose Core or Enriched Core for: English, Social Studies* and Science. Students are automatically registered for: Pre-Algebra, Health and Physical Education. *Students currently enrolled in Spanish Immersion courses may select Core Spanish Social Studies or Enriched Core Spanish Social Studies on their registration form.

Advanced & Accelerated Core Courses

Current MOSAIC students may select Advanced courses in the registration form. All other students may express interest in Advanced courses in the registration form. Students are qualified for Advanced courses based on specific entrance criteria which can be found in the [Curriculum Guide](#). Honors Algebra 7 is only available to students currently taking Pre-Algebra or students who have shown mastery of standards.

Fine Arts Electives

- Music: 7th graders will continue in the same Music Elective they took in 6th grade. Music will alternate daily with Physical Education.
- Visual Art/Theater Art: Students have a variety of options to choose from for their required Visual or Theater Art elective.

Pathway Elective

Students make one selection from each of the following Pathways: Business & Management and Engineering & Technology. These are semester long classes.

World Language Elective

Students will be able to select from the following semester options: Spanish, French, German, Chinese or Spanish Language Literature & Culture (for Spanish Immersion students). Please note that your World Language selection is a **two-year commitment**.

You will receive a registration confirmation email on March 4th with an opportunity to make changes to the courses you select. We look forward to partnering with you to further your student's education at CMS.
