

**For Household Members of Someone Who Tested Positive for COVID-19**

<p><b>IF:</b></p>	<p><b>You are not able to remain separated from the person with COVID-19 during their isolation period</b></p>	<p><b>Multiple people in your household test positive for COVID-19 on different dates (and you are not able to stay separated from them)</b></p>
<p><b>You are up-to-date with your COVID-19 vaccine</b></p>	<p><u>Quarantine is not necessary</u> (provided symptoms do not develop).</p> <p><u>Test</u> 5 days after you were first exposed and (if negative) test again 5 days after the end of the person with COVID-19's isolation period</p>	<p><u>Quarantine is not necessary</u> (provided symptoms do not develop).</p> <p><u>Test</u> 5 days after your initial exposure and again 5 days after the end of the last household member's isolation period.</p>
<p><b>You are unvaccinated or <u>not</u> up-to-date with your COVID-19 vaccines</b></p>	<p><u>Quarantine</u> throughout the isolation period of the household member with COVID-19 and continue to quarantine for an additional 5 days after the end of the household member's isolation period.</p> <p><u>Test</u> 5 days after you were first exposed and (if negative) test again 5 days after the end of the person with COVID-19's isolation period</p>	<p><u>Quarantine</u> throughout the isolation period of the last household member who tested positive for COVID-19 and continue to quarantine for an additional 5 days after that household member's isolation period ends.</p> <p><u>Test</u> 5 days after you were first exposed and (if negative) test again 5 days after the isolation period of the <b>last</b> infected household member ends.</p>
<p><b>You have a history of COVID-19 in the last 90 days (with recovery)</b></p>	<p><u>Quarantine and testing</u> is not necessary (provided symptoms do not develop)</p>
