Re: Bikeability Courses

Bikeability is the government's national cycling training programme. It teaches practical skills and understanding of how to cycle on today's roads. We would like to give pupils the opportunity to participate in these courses.

Please see below the Bikeability courses provided by East Sussex County Council's Road Safety Education Team:-

Bikeability Balance (Foundation and Year 1) (Balance bikes can be provided) £7.50 per child

For the remaining courses children are required to have a bike in good working order with correctly working brakes, etc. and a suitable helmet.

Level 1 – Years 2, 3 and 4 £10 per child (years 3 and 4)

Level 2 (years 5 and 6) Level 2 courses are FREE for children in receipt of Free School Meals or £20 per child

The year groups are general guidance for the ages of pupils on the courses.
