For those who are unaware, Community Services is the parks and recreation department for the Town of Scarborough. Beyond providing recreational opportunities for all ages and abilities, we maintain the town beaches and parks, schedule all town and school facilities, provide child care programs for Scarborough students, operate the cable access channels for local programming, accept U.S. passport applications . . . the list keeps going!

We also host several no-cost or low-cost public events that help bring friends, family, neighbors, local businesses and organizations together to celebrate the seasons. These events include Summerfest, the 55⁺ BBQ, Santa in the Park and Annual Tree Lighting, Winterfest, and Easter Egg Hunts, and our newly-added one-day events such as S'mores Socials in January, a live animal show in March, Mental Health Awareness Day in May, a Senior Citizen Prom in May, and Relay for Life in June.
