1. Minutes: Roshawn moved to approve the December 8, 2021 minutes and Tom seconded.
2. Due to conflicts with the Science Fair, the SCC did not address items 2, 4, 7, 8 of the agenda—they will be addressed in February.
3. Principal's Report/School Land Trust Plan Update:
  - a. The School had \$60,400 from the Land Trust (including carry over from 2021). It had two goals—reading proficiency in grades K-2 and science. IHE is on target to spend most of the allocated funds for the year.
  - b. Tom walked the council through how to access information about IHE from: <https://datagateway.schools.utah.gov/>. Go to compare schools, Salt Lake District – Indian Hills School. The list of similarly-situated schools is based on federal criteria. The scores reflect RISE data. For the most part, IHE's scores rose over the 2021 school-year (except in ELA where the scores remained constant). This doesn't reflect K-2 reading, where IHE scores actually went down. The K-2 teachers are focusing on reading this year to bring these scores back up.
  - c. We met our end-of-year goals last year except for ELA – where we stayed the same. But, it appears based on interim testing, that we will meet our goals this year as well.
  - d. The council discussed what is happening with kids missing schools based on omicron. Teachers do not have the tools necessary to provide a remote option with the rest of the class in person and Roshawn noted that it's difficult to provide work to students in advance because teachers may not get to the planned topics. Parents should work with teachers to make sure kids keep up in school.
