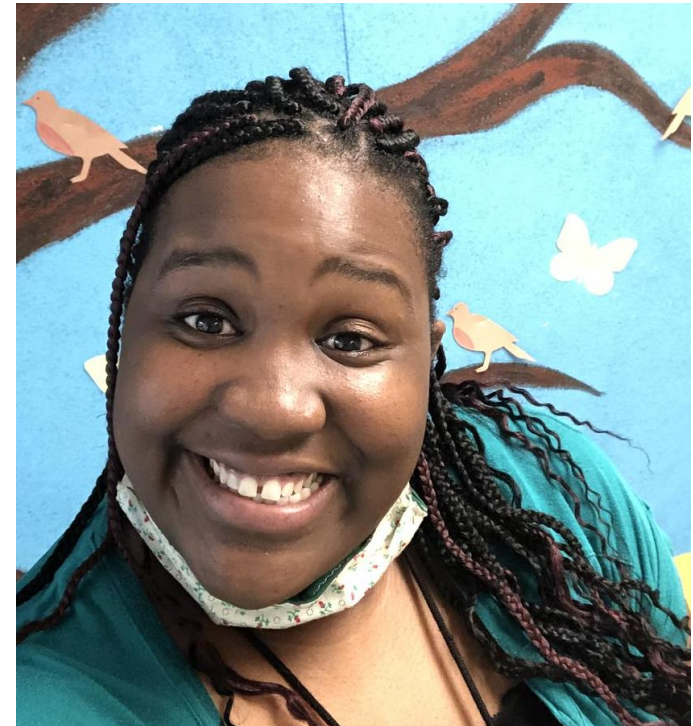

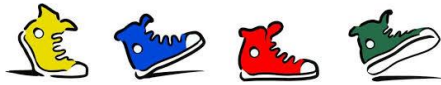

A day at Wayne Elementary...

- Arrival 8:55 to 9:00 (students need to be in their classroom by 9:05 am.)
 - bus(drop off in front circle)
 - car (car loop with adult supervision)
 - Walkers/bikers
- *all line up with classmates at an assigned door and adults monitor

Daily Schedule

- Each grade has:
 - Four core subjects (reading/literacy, math, social studies, and science)
 - A special daily (library, music, art, gym, wellness, STEM)
 - A 25 minute lunch and 25 minute recess.
 - Dedicated 50 minutes daily for MTSS to receive support, interventions, enrichment, music lessons, and other services if needed.

Title 1 Support

Wayne Elementary School receives Title 1 funds, which allow us to have additional literacy and math supports who qualify based on assessment data throughout various grade levels.

Title 1 support is regular education intervention to provide additional support that aligns with our curriculum.

Dismissal-please be mindful of procedures for notifying the office of changes in dismissal plans. You need to speak directly with someone in the office as email and voicemail may not be able to relay the message in time.

- Students pack up by 3:35pm
 - Dismissed at 3:40
 - Clubs- teachers dismiss/ Right at School in charge
 - Car loop (meet at a designated spot- adults walk them over to car loop)
 - After care (Right at School)
 - Walkers (have a signed permission/note in office)
 - Bus students (go to designated bus- adults are assigned to a bus to assist)
 - Buses leave by approximately 3:45-3:50 pm
