 1. STEAM Club
 - a) Programs/Cost
KidSpark- comes with lessons and PD for teacher, enough kits for a class of 26 (K-2), 32 (3-5), all reusable, \$7589.66
Sphero - comes with basic kit materials, Art element added, enough kits for a class of 26 (K-5), all reusable, ~\$5,400
LEGO - comes with lessons, STEM + Literacy (K-5), Robotics (3-5), enough kits for class of 26, all reusable, ~\$7,620
*all programs will require either a laptop or ipad
Computers - Chromebook @\$257 each X 12 = ~\$3,084, Macbook @\$1079 each X 12 = ~\$12,948

Certified staff = \$25/hr

2. Sports Club

a) Programs/Cost

Mrs. Lewis was unable to find any outside programs that come to the schools. Council members were hoping to find an outside program to be able to add the element of competition. Mr. Eldridge may have a contact to a sports program. He will look into it and report back at next meeting. Mr. Martinez has a martial arts contact and will report back at next meeting. If no program is available, we still have the option of paying a staff member to run a sports club.

B. Update on learning recovery intervention

COVID quarantines and isolations have meant that a good chunk of students are out at any given time. Teachers are continuing to make the best of what they have and move forward with all interventions and small groups. DIBELS progress monitoring is showing that our interventions are successful in making gains especially in K-2. Winter AZAC showed our 3rd grade overall at 56% proficient in reading (end of year goal is 55%), 4th overall 50% proficient (end of year goal is 48%) and 5th overall 51% proficient (end of year goal is 63%).
