Good Day, Lamoille Families:

The Vermont Agency of Human Services and the Vermont Department of Health (VTDOH) are announcing that additional vaccination clinics will be held for children ages 5 to 11, 12-18 first/second/booster dose, and adult-faculty and staff first/second/booster dose.

The next clinic will be held at the Community Education Center (CEC) of GMTCC from 9:00 a.m. – 1:00 p.m., Thursday, February 10, 2022, on the main campus located at 738 VT RTE 15 West, Hyde Park, VT 05655.

Parents and caregivers can register their eligible children to receive the Pfizer COVID-19 vaccine on the state website at [COVID-19 Vaccines for Children | Vermont Department of Health \(healthvermont.gov\)](https://healthvermont.gov/COVID-19/Vaccines-for-Children) or by calling 855-722-7878. Families may need to add their child as a dependent in the registration system and complete the pre-vaccination screening form. These are closed clinics (no public), except for parent/guardian accompanying a child. Any child can go to any school-sponsored site for the vaccine; it does not have to be the school that the child attends.
