## **JOLIET WEST HIGH SCHOOL DRIVER'S EDUCATION**

To inquire on the status to obtain your driver's license, enter your student instruction permit number into this site:  
<https://sec1.isbe.net/driveredweb/Inquiry.asp> (also located on the Drivers Ed Website) before going to the DMV.

### **WHAT TO BRING TO RECEIVE YOUR LICENSE**

- 1) Permit (9 months and one day from issued date).
- 2) Official Birth Certificate (not a copy).
- 3) Social Security Card (make sure the card is signed).
- 4) 50-Hour Driving Log with at least 10-night driving hours signed by parent.
- 5) Proof of Insurance and Registration on vehicle to be used for the road test.
- 6) Vehicle **MUST BE** in proper working order.

*Your driving test will be graded on a negative testing system. You start with a zero (perfect score) and points will be deducted accordingly as you drive. You may lose up to and including 35 points. 36 or more is a failure. The driving test itself will usually last 10 to 20 minutes. The driver facility is closed on Sundays and Mondays. The best days to go for the shortest lines are usually Wednesdays and Thursdays. There is no fee required because of the \$20.00 permit fee includes your first license.*
