Course Description

This course equips students with the essential language arts skills needed throughout their academic careers. Students read and analyze a variety of texts. Instruction and reading strategies accompany reading selections to help engage students and sharpen their comprehension. Students express their ideas and knowledge using standard (formal) English in written and oral assignments. The course includes discussion activities that engage students in the curriculum while creating a sense of community.

Google Classroom

- Students will use Google Classroom to:
 - Submit synchronous and asynchronous course work (assignments, discussions, class activities etc.) complete and on time
 - Monitor course announcements/updates
 - Monitor complete, incomplete, or missing assignments

Due Dates & Late Work

It is the student's responsibility to turn in all online work before the designated due date. A 10 point deduction will be made from the student's grade for each day work is turned in passed the due date. Any work turned in after the unit deadline will be graded at the discretion of the teacher. Students absent when work is due shall be given one school day for each day of excused absence to make up missing assignments. It is the responsibility of the student to contact their teacher upon returning to school and schedule any quiz or exam they may have missed while absent. **Grades are finalized and posted through Infinite Campus. Students/parents must monitor grades/missing assignments through Infinite Campus along with Google Classroom.** Students must communicate with their teacher regarding meeting during tutorial/asynchronous times to work on assignments/missing work. The scheduled time is at the discretion of the teacher. Make up work extensions will be at the discretion of the teacher. If you do not understand an assignment or the material, please ask so that I can clarify the matter. Also, email me if you have a question or contact me via Remind.

Technical Support:

Students are advised to contact Stride K12 for any technical issues regarding their program. Students must stay in contact with

Retesting Procedures:

Students are expected to communicate with their teacher regarding late work, missing work, and retesting. The time and date to retest/meet for virtual tutorials will be determined by the teacher. A retest may raise the score to a maximum grade of **70**. **Quarter Exams and Semester Exams do not qualify for retesting.**
