



Vancouver College Announces New Head Football Coach!

After a comprehensive search process with strong, university-experienced candidates from Quebec, Ontario, Alberta and BC, Vancouver College is pleased to share the appointment of Bryan Chiu (VC '92) as Head Football Coach commencing in the summer of 2022.

Bryan was an outstanding football player for the Fighting Irish. He went on to star at Washington State University where he completed a Bachelor of Arts in Social Sciences majoring in Sports Management. He was drafted in 1996 by the Montreal Alouettes where he played for 13 years. During his career, he was recognized as a CFL All Star on seven occasions and was a member of two Grey Cup winning teams. He then turned his attention to coaching and served as the Offensive Line Coach for various CFL teams including the BC Lions, the Toronto Argonauts, and Ottawa Redblacks. He was selected as one of the top fifty all-time greatest CFL players. After retiring from the CFL in 2019, Bryan returned to his alma mater as part of the coaching staff and was instrumental in the 2019 Provincial Championship win for Vancouver College.

Under his leadership, Bryan hopes to continue the great work of his predecessor, Todd Bernett, and live out the Essential Elements in his coaching by "celebrating the value and dignity of each person and nurturing the whole person's development." He will use his depth and breadth of experience, innovation, and passion for the success of our boys, and our faith and learning community. He looks forward to establishing relationships and mentoring our student-athletes into becoming better men.
