If you are not planning to enroll your child in kindergarten in the Mankato Area Public Schools this fall, please call the Central Registration office at 507-387-2125 or email <u>centralregistration@isd77.org</u> to give us that information so you can be removed from our enrollment list.

Kindergarten Roundup - Please visit our website the last week of March for information regarding Kindergarten Roundup plans for this year. If the pandemic requires a different plan, we will communicate those through the website as well.

Please either email scanned copies of the birth certificate and immunization records to centralregistration@isd77.org or fax them to 507-387-2618 or you can stop into our office and we will make copies of the records.

If your child is <u>NOT</u> attending Mankato Area Public Schools please call Central Registration to inform them of your plans. This will remove your child's enrollment and our staff will no longer follow up with you throughout the summer about completing the registration process for Kindergarten in ISD 77.

- ☐ Immunizations Please provide the most current documentation of required Immunizations. Please see the letter from Mankato Area Schools Health Services.
- ☐ Official State Issued Birth Certificate. The State of Minnesota requires parents to provide a copy of a legal Birth Certificate at the time of Kindergarten Registration. Please provide a copy of the birth certificate. We do not accept the Hospital Certificate (the one with the footprints) as it is not a legal document. If you do not own a Birth Certificate and your child was born in MN, you can get a legal birth certificate at the Government Center in Mankato located 410 S 5th St. Parents/Guardians need to bring an ID to the Government Center and the cost is \$26. If your child was born in another state, contact the county courthouse in the state your child was born.
- □ Early Childhood Screening is to be completed prior to the start of the Kindergarten year and through the age of 5 years old. To make an appointment for this Spring, please call the Central Registration at 507-387-2125 to schedule an appointment with our office. Limited appointments are only available in early September 2022 and are not offered during the summer. If your child has already had a screening in the Mankato School district, we have those records and you do not need to schedule an appointment or supply screening records.
- ☐ **Transportation Forms** if your address is eligible for bus transportation, a form will be emailed to you once your online registration is uploaded. To determine if your address is eligible for busing or to determine the assigned school please go to www.isd77.org. In the Search bar, search for Bus Transportation, then click "Determine Eligibility for Busing".

Online Options

Online Option 1: Parent Portal (if you have an account with your older children in our district)

This option only applies if you have a child currently enrolled in our district **AND you have an Infinite Campus Parent Portal account.

Online Option 2: Website

OUR ONLINE REGISTRATION PROCESS IS NOT CELL PHONE FRIENDLY

- 1. Go to www.isd77.org --- Click Enroll.
 - a. Step by Step Visual Online Registration Instructions will be on the Enroll page
- 2. On the Central Registration page, click the "Click for Registration" blue box.
- 3. Read the detailed information on the "Resident Registration" page
- 4. Click the blue box "K-12 New Student Online Registration" and type required information and then click Begin Registration.
- 5. You will receive an email from a DO NOT REPLY email with the secure link to begin the registration.

Our registration process is only available online and it is connected to our database which prompts notifications to specific departments depending on your answers (health concerns, Special Ed, English Learner and parent release forms).

If a computer or laptop is not available to you, please consider stopping into the Central Registration office to use our guest computers or use the Public Library computers. This process is **NOT phone friendly.**

Central Registration Office Hours:

Please arrive an hour before closing to ensure there is enough time to complete the process as Central Registration only has two guest computers.

TO: PARENTS OR GUARDIANS

FROM: MANKATO AREA SCHOOLS HEALTH SERVICE

We welcome your child to kindergarten and look forward to working with you in maintaining your child's health throughout his/her school years.

The Minnesota School Immunization Law requires that your child have documentation of certain immunizations on file with the school district before your child can start kindergarten this fall. Documentation of the following immunizations will be required:

- **DTaP** (diphtheria, tetanus, pertussis): 5 doses (Fifth shot not needed if 4th was after age 4. Final dose of DTaP must be on or after age 4.)
- **Polio:** 4 doses (4th shot not needed if 3rd was after age 4. Final dose of polio must be on or after age 4.)
- MMR (measles, mumps, and rubella): 2 doses given after first birthday
- **Hepatitis B:** a series of 3 immunizations given over a six-month period
- **Varicella** (chickenpox): 2 doses **or** documentation of disease history (including the year) <u>signed by the health care provider.</u>

In addition to the required immunizations, we recommend a physical examination by your child's healthcare provider and a dental checkup by your child's dentist. Please call your health care provider's office for an appointment as soon as possible. Complete and return the Pupil Immunization Record and sign Box 3. If your child will not be receiving any of these immunizations for **medical reasons** have your health care provider sign 1A. or because of your **conscientiously held beliefs** sign 1B. Conscientious exemptions must be notarized. Sign Box 3 if you agree to share your child's immunization information with Minnesota's immunization registry (MIIC).

Before your child can attend school this fall, proof of immunizations or a completed exemption form must be on file with the Health Service Office at East or West High School. Mail the completed record as soon as possible to:
