Along with you, I want to express my deep gratitude to Adrianne Jewett for her many years of faithful service to our OLGC school community. In her five years as principal, she has demonstrated tremendous leadership, compassion, creativity, dedication, and unparalleled devotion to our students, faculty, staff, and parents.

With you, I am very sad to see her leave our community and go to Linton Hall School, Bristow, VA, as the new Head of School. Despite our efforts to entice her to stay with financial incentives, flexible work hours, and additional administrative help, it is clear to me that this change is a very good move for Adrianne, her family, and her quality of life. ANOTHER SCAM, CONT'D. – Following up on last week's story of a scam that was attempted on my computer, here's the story of an elderly couple, in their own words, who actually clicked on the phone number on their screen. After all we've been reading about the dangers lurking out there, they were apparently convinced this was a legitimate problem. Here's their story.

"Two weeks ago, we turned on our PC to see a full screen notice, with the Microsoft logo, that said that Microsoft had blocked access to our computer due to a Trojan infection. We were not to try and close the message as that would damage our computer, but to call an 800 number immediately to have the virus removed. If this happens to you do not make this call!!

Microsoft will never do this. These were sophisticated hackers that told us they found 7 hackers, and one had already taken \$22,000 from our checking account. Looking back, there were many red flags! They voluntarily gave us their employee ID numbers, gave us a case number and password to use, and told us they could find any other hackers. They said they already rid us of the virus, offered us free upgraded Firewall protection that covers all current and future devices, wanted to create a new bank account for us so the FBI could track the money, send us new checks, and made many more almost believable statements. They connected us to one of our bank's representatives in the Fraud Department to start the process of involving the FBI. This person turned out to be part of the hacker's team, as was the person supposedly from the FBI Fraud Team that was available to us immediately.

Their goal was to have me go directly to my bank, request an "international Money Transfer Form" and complete it with the information they emailed me on my cell phone (including the amount of money supposedly already taken), and use my cell phone to tape my conversation with bank personnel.

If you encounter a problem like this and accidentally call the number, discontinue the conversation immediately. DO use another device; contact Microsoft immediately and tell them the problem. They will check your computer for unauthorized activity and determine if your system is really locked. Then, contact your bank to assure no money was transferred from your account without your authorization." We hear so much about this kind of thing, but I've never read such a detailed description of what happens when a hacker gets you on his hook. Important to remember is that these people could have disconnected themselves at any time during the conversation. I noticed they didn't say how they finally got off the hook. Perhaps reading about an actual hacker encounter will make you more vigilant.

So, what to do if you do get hacked? First, call your internet provider. If you're locked out by hackers, they can help you get back in. Secondly, call your bank to confirm that none of your accounts have been affected.
