Prepare and Share

The Atlantic hurricane season runs June 1 to November 30. These storms also bring the risk of downed trees and power lines, which can cause loss of electrical power and cellphone service.

Here are some tips to help you prepare. Please share this information with family and friends.

- Make sure you are prepared in case you lose power.
 - Charge cellphone and other devices.
 - Have a few days of food and water available.
 - Have a battery-operated radio available.
- Determine your best protection for high winds and flooding.
- Evacuate if told to do so.
- Take shelter in a designated storm shelter or an interior room for high winds.
- Do not walk, swim, or drive through floodwaters.
- Only use generators outdoors and away from windows.
- Listen for emergency information and alerts.
- Make sure you are signed up for West Hartford's Community Advisory Notification System found on the Town's website: westhartfordct.gov
