Prepare and Share

Here are some tips to help you prepare. Please share this information with family and friends.

- Failing to evacuate flooded areas, entering floodwaters, or remaining after a flood has passed can result in injury or death.
- Do not walk, swim, or drive through floodwaters.
- Stay off bridges over fast-moving water.
- Determine your best protection based on the type of flooding
 - Evacuate if told to do so
 - Move to higher ground or higher floor
 - Stay where you are
- Do not walk, swim, or drive through flood waters
- Flash floods can come without warning. They can develop both slowly or quickly.
- Floods cause outages, disrupt transportation, damage buildings, and create landslides.
- Make sure you are signed up for West Hartford's Community Advisory Notification System found on the Town's website: westhartfordct.gov
