- Go to the menu (three lines upper right-hand corner)




Getting Started with SORA on Chromebook


Click on the three lines and then "Add a public library"



Adding Mid-Columbia Libraries to SORA

Click on "Add a public Library" and then type 99336 into the field






Find a book you want and read/listen

 You can search Mid-Columbia Libraries for a good book. If you know the title or author enter it in the search bar.



Find a book you want and read/listen

 Read the summary of the book by clicking on the cover. If the summary sounds good click on "Borrow". The book will open in your Chromebook. Read it by clicking forward/back arrows.



Find a book you want and read/listen

You can also search by category.



 Once SORA has opened click on the three lines in the top righthand corner and click on Kennewick School District.




You can now access Park's Audio Books plus some free books from SORA...

Your dashboard

 When you close out of your book (upper left—hand corner) your dashboard will appear at the bottom of your screen.



Your Dashboard has many features (Home, Explore, Shelf, Me



Dashboard continued

- The Home link will tell you what books you have checked out, defined words, notes and highlights, and books you might like.
- The Explore link will take you back to browsing the library giving you suggestions.
- The Shelf link will help you manage your loans. You may return titles here by going to Options (beside book).
- The Me link will allow you to give yourself a nickname and track your progress.










SORA vs. OVERDRIVE app on your phone

Adding KSD as a Library


- Search by Postal Code

- Click Search




Adding KSD as a Library...continued
