

Ancient Egyptian Civilization

Year 3 Term 2A, 2021-2022

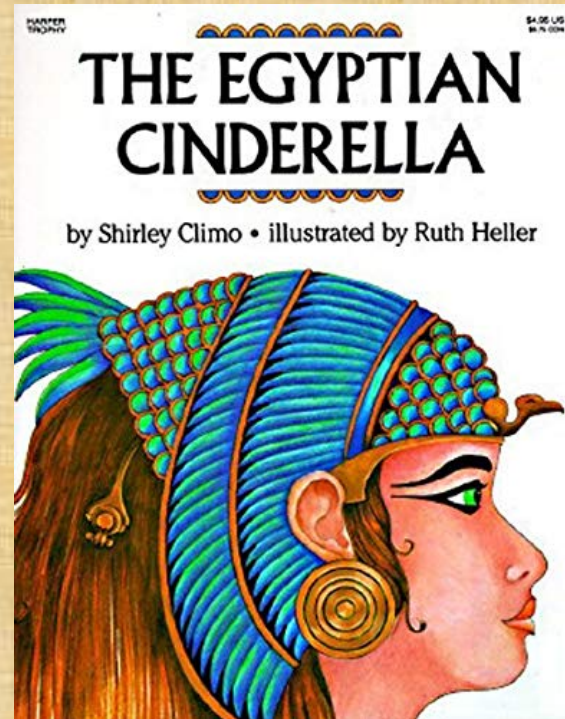
Curriculum Overview

In Computing, children will start looking into coding. They will begin to understand how games and apps work and identify what an algorithm is. They will learn the following key features of coding; sequencing, debugging, visual coding, sprite and repeated commands. Based on this understanding, the students will then make their own dancing robot game.

In English, our work will be based on the story, 'The Egyptian Cinderella'. The students will start by responding to the text and sequencing the main events of the story. The students will then familiarize themselves with a range of non-fiction texts, including newspaper reports. They will identify the features and layout of a newspaper report, including headlines and eye-witness accounts. Students will learn how to utilize these features in planning and eventually writing their own newspaper report based on key events from the story.

Students will then edit and revise their writing, before publishing their final draft. Subsequently, they will get the opportunity to practise their speaking and listening skills by presenting their work to their peers.

Towards the end of this half-term, we will revisit the topic of Poetry. Using the poem, 'The Crocodile' by Lewis Carroll, we will explore the structure, language and poetic techniques included in poetry and get a chance to practise reading and comprehending and performing a poem.



In PSHE this half-term, we will be introducing student council meetings every other week for students to share their thoughts and ideas. Students will learn about the uses of water in our lives and consider why and how we need to conserve water. Based on this, students will design different methods and products that could help us conserve water.

In Science, students will recognise that we need light in order to see and explore the sun as a light source. They will investigate shadows by exploring; how shadows are formed, how shadows behave and how the size of shadows change throughout the day. Children will then explore how light is reflected from surfaces and understand how our eyes allow us to see. Finally, the students will investigate the colours in white light.

In Maths, we will start off with revising and consolidating their 2, 4 and 8 times-tables and practise multiplying 2-digits by 1-digit.

We will then move on to fractions. We will start this unit by having a practical week where students will create fractions, understand visual and written representation of fractions, and begin to understand equivalent fractions. Children will then learn about unit and non-unit fractions, find and count in tenths, and identify tenths as a decimal.

Following this, we will look into money using British and Egyptian pounds. They will practise counting and converting money in pounds and pence. Students will then learn to add and subtract amounts of money, including giving change.

Our last math unit this half-term will be 'time'. Children will begin by understanding months and years. They will also identify the hours in a day before telling the time to the nearest 5-minute and 1-minute intervals. They will then practise telling the time using the am and pm and the 24-hour clock.

In Foundation Subjects, children will start off by making a papyrus picture and a replica of an ancient Egyptian cartouche. They will then design, evaluate and make a shaduf. Students will delve deeper into the ancient Egyptian period by placing key events on a timeline and finding out how their society was organised. Children will learn about Pharaohs and ancient Egyptian Gods and Goddesses, and also learn about the Pyramids and other achievements of this time period. Students will then learn to locate Egypt on a map and find out about some of the geographical features of Egypt, including the river Nile.
