Step one







- Select tournaments from the options down the left side of the page (second from the top)



Step six

- Select advanced search, which is at the bottom right of the options as shown below.

Step seven

- Scroll down the page, and select the age group which your child is in. You can use the table below if you are unsure or alternatively the LTA age group calculator (this will appear on google after being typed in and searched for).

Step eight

- Filter your results using the other filter options down the right hand side of the page, and then press search. Grade 6/7 tournaments are matchplay events where players will play other players of the same rating and should be of a very similar standard. Grade 4/5 tournaments are county level tournaments, grade 3 tournaments are regional level tournaments and it is recommended that several tournaments of grade 4-7 should be played to gain experience prior to entering these higher standard events.
- Only events which are open to entries can be entered however upcoming events will open for entries in the future (they specify the date if you click on the tournament).

Grade 7

If you are just starting to compete, Grade 7 competitions offer a great opportunity to gain some competitive experience in a local environment. These include local competitions such as club or squad box leagues and ladders. This grade of competition counts for ratings but not rankings. To find out more contact your local tennis venue or LTA regional office.

Grade 6

Competitions in this grade are usually match-plays which are open to all players to enter. They are run throughout the year and across the country and offer players in all age groups the chance to develop their competitive tennis. This grade of competition counts for ratings but not rankings.

Grade 5

These competitions take place at local club or county level and are open to players of all ages and abilities. They might be for specific age groups or cater for different age groups within one tournament. These competitions count for both ratings and rankings. From September 2019, players will be accepted for Grade 5 competitions on a First Come, First Served basis. [Find out more information about this change.](#)

Grade 4

These are county level competitions giving players the opportunity to gain competition experience at the next level and count for both ratings and rankings.

Grade 3

These are regional level competitions that count for both ratings and rankings. There are opportunities for players of all ages to compete in grade 3 competitions throughout the year.

Grade 2


These are national level competitions and count for both ratings and rankings.

Grade 1

This is the top level of national competition and counts for ratings and rankings.


Step nine



- Agree to tournament terms and conditions (bottom row of page)




Step twelve
