

Preschool Quarantine Policy Update

After consultation with local health and safety organizations, our Preschool is implementing a program that is seeing success in other early childhood education centers - locally and nationally - <u>which will allow your child to continue to attend</u> <u>school in person</u> if you choose.

Students who are <u>exposed together</u> can now remain in the classroom with other exposed classmates for five days after the date of last exposure. This Cohort Quarantine protocol involves the following parameters:

- <u>The class will be kept entirely separate from the rest of the</u> <u>preschool</u>. Any children taking part in this cohort will:
 - Pass a temperature screening at the front desk
 - Remain in a separate classroom for all activities including early morning care and aftercare
 - Have their own recess time separate from the rest of the Preschool
 - Take part in an amended schedule of activities and specials separate from all other classes
- <u>All participants must be asymptomatic</u>. Any child who exhibits symptoms of COVID-19 will be sent home and will not be permitted to return to campus without a negative COVID-19 test result or physician's note clearing them for return.
- **Students who are fully vaccinated against COVID-19** will be permitted to take part in early/aftercare, as well as clubs or other activities.

Each cohort's quarantine will depend on the date of last exposure to the COVID-19-positive individual - as well as the date of the positive test result - so long as no other child tests positive. Should a family choose for their child **not** to participate, they should alert the classroom teachers via the HiMama app.
