

## STUDENTS WITH LIMITED OR INTERRUPTED FORMAL EDUCATION (SLIFE) TEACHER

## BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF POSITION:

Under the direction of a site administrator, teaches one or more of the content areas to Students with Limited or Interrupted Formal Education (SLIFE) Teacher and assist in other school programs as assigned.

## **ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- 1. Teaches one of several content areas (ELD/Spanish/Social Science/Math and AVID-EL). Utilizes Board adopted courses which emphasizes basic literacy development skills in reading, writing, speaking and listening.
- 2. Instructs pupils in basic communication and literacy skills, and other general elements of the course of study common to SLIFE students, as specified in State law and administrative regulations and procedures of the District.
- 3. Continuously evaluates each pupil's progress in literacy and English skills in listening, speaking, reading, and writing and prepares progress reports.
- 4. Adapts material and methods to develop relevant sequential assignments that guide and challenge students.
- 5. Determines instructional materials designed to achieve instructional goals and behavioral objectives. Selects books and instructional aids appropriate to the interest, maturity and literacy levels of students.
- 6. Provides individual and small groups instruction in order to adapt the curriculum to the needof each pupil.
- 7. Encourages pupils to think independently and to express original ideas.
- 8. Continuously evaluates each pupil's progress in literacy and English skills in listening, speaking, reading and writing, and prepares progress reports.
- 9. Establishes and maintains standards of pupil behavior needed to provide an orderly, productive classroom environment.
- 10. Maintains professional competence through participation in in-service education activities provided by the district and/or in self-selected professional growth activities.
