WHAT'S NEW?

In June, the development of the new middle school continued with a shift to interior design and specific room needs. Bray Architects continues to meet with different user groups from the district with conversations detailing the specific layout, needs, and desires for the future of their curriculum. The day after the final day of school, construction kicked off on this year's secure entry projects. The schedule for these improvements is tight; however, Miron Construction is making great progress in the first four weeks.

PLANNING & DESIGN UPDATE

At the middle school, the focus has shifted to interior finishes. Please take a look at the preliminary images of the commons and library collaboration areas. On these renderings, please note all furniture pictured is preliminary as designs and meetings are ongoing.

For next year's secure entry projects, we are holding ongoing discussions to determine the best layout for each of the four sites. These conversations will help shape how the exterior will look once these projects are complete.

WHAT'S NEXT?

- » The City of Oshkosh required a traffic study for the new middle school site. This study is being finalized and forwarded to Bray Architects, OASD, and the City of Oshkosh for review.
- » We're continuing to develop interior design at the middle school.
- » We've started setting up tours in the greater Fox Valley area for the middle school user group to see their curriculum in action.
