WHAT'S NEW?

In July, construction on this summer's projects turned the corner from closing-up walls to applying finishes, the finish line is in sight on these projects! The middle school design is in full swing as smaller groups of specific staff (such as special education, media specialists, etc.) attended tours of North Fond du Lac Learning Center and Winneconne High School to see their specific curriculum spaces in recently constructed facilities. Early design work on North High School, West High School, Oakwood Elementary, and Read Elementary continue to make good progress as the floor plans, preliminary exteriors, and site plans are taking shape.

PLANNING & DESIGN UPDATE

At the middle school, the results of the traffic study were delivered to the School District and the City of Oshkosh.

Meetings regarding the site layout and site access between Bray Architects, OASD, and the City of Oshkosh will continue over the next two or three months.
