ANONYMOUS REPORTING

When reporting anonymously, please consider the following:

- The report may be treated as informational only if an investigation is unable to be completed with the information provided.
- Depending on the information provided, an investigation may or may not occur.
- Depending on the hotline that you choose to report to, resources may or may not be provided to you.

- You have the option to report confidentially or non-confidentially.
- Depending on the information provided, an investigation may or may not occur.
- Depending on the information provided, an investigation may be mandatory according to the law.
