Dear Rochester Community Schools Families,

The Oakland County Health Division (OCHD) announced this morning at approximately 10 a.m. that **effective Feb. 28, 2022**, the [Emergency Order \(2021-01\) for Control of Pandemic](#) will be rescinded. Individuals in Oakland County schools and daycares will no longer be required to wear face coverings.

For Rochester Community Schools students, staff and visitors, facial coverings are required until the public health order expires on Feb. 28. We will collaborate with RCS administrators and public health officials to evaluate processes and procedures and share updates as they become available.
