- Please provide a signed statement from the supervising adult associated with your service work, verifying your participation and attesting to the contribution you have made through your work.

Scholarship Essay

On a separate sheet, please answer **one** of the following essay questions in 400-500 words:

- Write about a time when you overcame an obstacle in your life. What was this obstacle? How did it affect you? Did it affect others? Would you react to the obstacle differently now than you did then?
