220 COURSES BEYOND INSTRUCTIONAL PROGRAM

The purpose of this policy is to provide direction regarding students who complete an instructional program sequence in any academic discipline of the high school curriculum prior to graduation.

“Instructional program sequence” shall mean all courses of study within an academic discipline that are offered as part of the high school’s program of studies.

The District shall not provide either additional courses of study or funds for out-of-district courses to students to pursue coursework beyond the instructional program sequence. Nevertheless, the guidance departments of each high school will assist students who so desire to locate and arrange to take, at the student’s expense, appropriate courses in post-high school educational institutions. As an alternative, students may apply as provided in the policy guide entitled, “Independent Study.”
