- A discussion of COVID policies at the school.

- Discussed creating potential venues of getting input from parents. A town hall with a set of parents differing in opinion will not result in better outcome.

- Gather vaccination information from the community and present that.

- Discussed parent concerns on why certain decisions were made and should be more transparent (field trip cancelled for example). Kids stay in class for Clubhouse but ski bus has kids from Lower to Upper in one bus.
