

I. CALL TO ORDER/FLAG SALUTE

VIII. BOARD MEMBERS – OPEN DISCUSSION

Mr. Shi asked that the schools open up the doors early for students to enter due to the cold weather. He spoke about the grading in the Parent Portal and the John P. Stevens High School math policy. Mr. Shi also reported that February is open enrollment for Kindergarten and asked if Kindergarten will be full day.

Mr. Rivera stated that he is on the inclement weather team at his school and reported what they do for the students. He spoke about grading and how teachers lose prep time covering other classes. Mr. Rivera also spoke about full-day Kindergarten and Start Strong issues and asked for a breakdown by school for the programs in place.

Mrs. White discussed the Parent Help Desk, transportation issues and a lost Edison resident.

Mr. M. Patel discussed assessments and life skills.

Mr. B. Patel applauded Mr. Ross and the Edison High School Staff for their diverse culture and spoke about Start Strong.

Mrs. Bodofsky reported that March is Virtual Read Across America month.

Mrs. Madhukar felt the schools should open the doors early for students throughout the whole school year.

Mr. Schneider gave highlights on the committee chairpersons.

Mrs. Peng thanked the Administration for the Strong Summer Sessions. She felt the PSAT tests should be free to all students and requested an analysis on these test results.

IX. PUBLIC COMMENTS

Maria Orchid, resident, discussed life skills for students, air purifiers in classrooms, spacing for changing classrooms, how to help teachers and staff with mental health issues, upgrading gym equipment, welcoming diversity/inclusion, volunteers needed in schools and a sustained green team.

A resident questioned a complaint regarding a conflict of interest with a board member. He also questioned the hiring of the new board attorney.

Christo Makroupolos, resident, questioned Mrs. Madhukar's relationship with the Metuchen Mayor. He spoke about the library replacement, asked why there are police present at meetings and asked why speaking time has been reduced. He also spoke about the Human Relations Committee and asked that the board hire the most qualified lawyer.

Tony DePasquale, resident, asked if the School Board logo was copyrighted.

Elizabeth Conway, resident, felt Mr. Schneider and Mr. Rivera should abstain on the vote for the December Board Minutes since they were not members of the Board at that time and spoke about Start Strong for additional help for students. She also questioned the appointment for the softball coach.

A resident felt in-person schooling was better for the students, but schools need to be cautious. They also spoke about hybrid learning and felt school COVID cases were going down, with only 600 cases in the schools now.

Manish Patel, resident, discussed the traffic issues near John P. Stevens High School and felt Miller Street should be opened up for traffic. He also questioned the monies divided between the two high schools for the music programs.

A resident discussed a busing issue with Middlesex County Vocational School buses EV1 and EV3.

Matt Hrevnak, ETEA Vice President, welcomed the new Board Attorney, discussed math teachers covering classes and stated there were eight COVID cases with John P. Stevens High School teachers.
