How Can I Help?

A one-time donation of \$25 will buy a student a bus pass or gas card to help ensure they make it to class. When a student is feeling the weight of the world on their shoulders, this small act can keep them in school because they know someone cares about them.

A one-time donation of \$100 will help a student keep their utilities on, or turn them back on. A one-time donation of \$100 could also provide much needed grocery money to a young parent so they can put food on the table for their children.

A donation of \$240 can help a student avoid being evicted from their home, and help them continue their academic progress. In 2013 alone, we helped more than 16 students keep their homes by helping them pay rent.
