The Smoky Row Community is proud to present outstanding Carmel High School graduating seniors with the opportunity to receive the Smoky Row Elementary Alumni Scholarship. Current Smoky Row students, teachers and PTO have worked together to arrange for recipients to be awarded up to a \$1,000 scholarship. We are proud to offer a SRE Alumni scholarship as well as a Rising Rocket Award for a former Smoky Row student that has overcome great adversity to succeed at Carmel High School. Please note the Smoky Row PTO Scholarship Committee reserves the right to change the amount of scholarship monies rewarded to recipients.

Applicants must have attended Smoky Row during at least three grades and must be pursuing a collegiate or vocational degree. The following criteria will be considered:

Academic Performance,
Extracurricular Activities,
Community Service,
and Written Essay.

These categories will be equally weighed during the evaluation process. Financial aid will also be a consideration for both.

While recipients will be announced at the CHS Community Scholarship Night, the scholarship winners will also be expected to speak briefly to the Smoky Row student body either during a convocation or via a taped interview. It is intended that the scholarship money be used for the recipients' school expenses. Money will be mailed directly to the recipients' selected school for the fall semester.
