

Parent Request for a Particular Classroom Teacher

Note to administrator: If a student fails to perform satisfactorily on a third, fifth, or eighth grade math or reading assessment, the law allows a parent or guardian to make a request for the student to be assigned to a particular classroom teacher in the applicable subject area for the subsequent school year, if more than one classroom teacher is available in that area, by following the established process of the District. The District is not required to grant the request. To better manage staffing and scheduling in advance of the start of the school year, consider offering parents and guardians the opportunity to request a different teacher over the summer.

Note: To better manage staffing and scheduling in advance of the start of the school year, this request must be submitted to the campus principal by August 1.
