



7.1 Budget Update

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SoWashCo Schools Budget Update

At its Jan. 21, 2021 meeting, the School Board:

- Approved \$9,044,644 in reductions to the General Fund budget
 - Approved an increase of \$290,200 to the revenue budget
 - Directed Administration to seek an increase of \$6.6 million in its operating levy
 - Approved total adjustments in 22-23 General Fund of \$7,939,177
 - Approved total adjustments in 23-24 General Fund of \$7,860,401

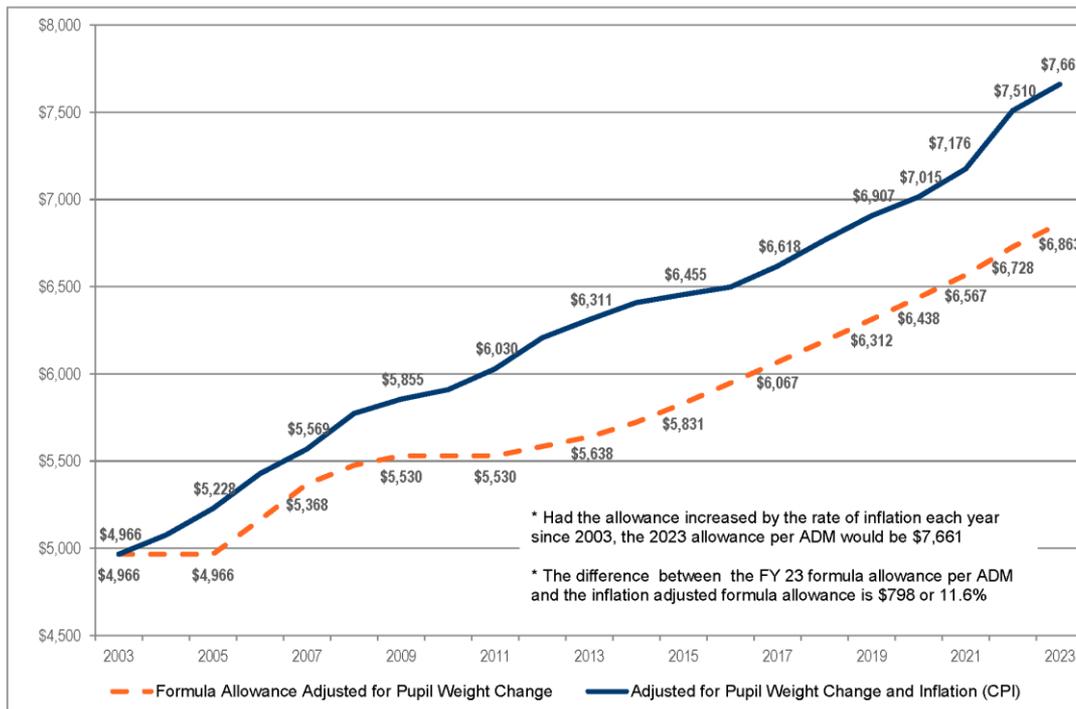


- Those changes were implemented into the 2021-22 Budget
- With the changes the District was able to present a balanced budget
- The 2021-22 budget uses a projected enrollment of 18,472 students
- Projected Enrollment as of Feb 1, 2022 is 18,529 students
- An increase of 57 students
- The District is paid an average of \$10,500 per student
- Revenue is affected by the amount of the basic formula
- The largest portion of the District's revenue is determined by multiplying the number of students by the basic formula

Recent Enrollment History

- The school year of 2019–20 produced the district’s largest enrollment of 18,754
- The full pandemic school year of 2020–21 showed enrollment dropping to 18,502
- The drop of 1.34% was less than most metro school districts.
- It resulted in a drop of over \$2.6 million from the previous year



Financial Forecasts

- The unassigned general fund balance should hover around 7% at the end of this 2021-22
- Revenue increases in 2022-23 include:
 - Enrollment - \$900,000
 - Formula - \$2,727,787
 - Operating Levy Increase - \$6,000,000
 - Special Education - \$1,500,000
 - Equity Adjustment - (\$707,000)
- About \$ 10,464,000





Financial Forecasts

- Expenditure Increases include:
 - Cost of Living - \$ 6,420,000
 - Supplies - \$ 96,140
 - Services - \$ 1,661,793
- $\$8,177,933$
- If we need to add FTE's, \$100,000 per teacher
- Leaves about \$2,000,000 for fund balance





Legislative Actions

- This session is not a funding session
- Surplus Available
- A few bills that may increase the formula
- 1% for SoWashCo is about \$1,400,000
- The Governor has proposed an increase to the formula
- Special Education Funding is being considered
