-Welcome - Stephanie Reeves, Co-Chairwoman

-Randi Owen, Co-Chairwoman, reviewed the responsibilities of the SHAC in regards to the new legislation about the sex education curriculum. Handouts with the information were available for the attendees. There was time allowed for questions and discussion.

-Judy Kinney with AIM for Success/Just Say Yes presented an overview of the program they provide to educate students about sex education via zoom. The sex education program is appropriate for grade levels 6 - 12. There are two mental health programs available, one is for grades K - 5 and the other is geared for grades 6 - 12. There was time allowed for discussion and questions at the end of the presentation. The presentation was recorded and will be posted on the KISD/SHAC website.

-Next, Stephanie Reeves updated the committee that the district is still providing free COVID tests for the staff and students. Everyone was happy to hear her report that the numbers are going down. The district nurses offer strep testing as well.

-Nurse Reeves showed the video that was created by one of the media classes at the high school promoting the district's partnership with Hazel Health. They provide physical health and mental health free of charge to KISD students.

-Texas Mobile Imaging was a successful experience for the district. Over 152 people were diagnosed. Statistics will be reported at a later date.

-Hope Campbell shared that the Methodist Health System Mobile Mammography Unit is scheduled to be in the district on March 28th and March 29th.

-Stephanie Reeves announced that the next meeting is scheduled for March 30th 2022 at 12:00 p.m. at the Administration Building.
