RESOLUTION IN RECOGNITION OF BLACK HISTORY MONTH 2022

WHEREAS, Black History Month encourages society and schools to celebrate the history, contributions, achievements of Black Americans; and

All services are **confidential**. No information about you or your family situation will be shared with school personnel without your permission in accordance with state and federal law.

When to use the program

- Persists for more than several weeks
