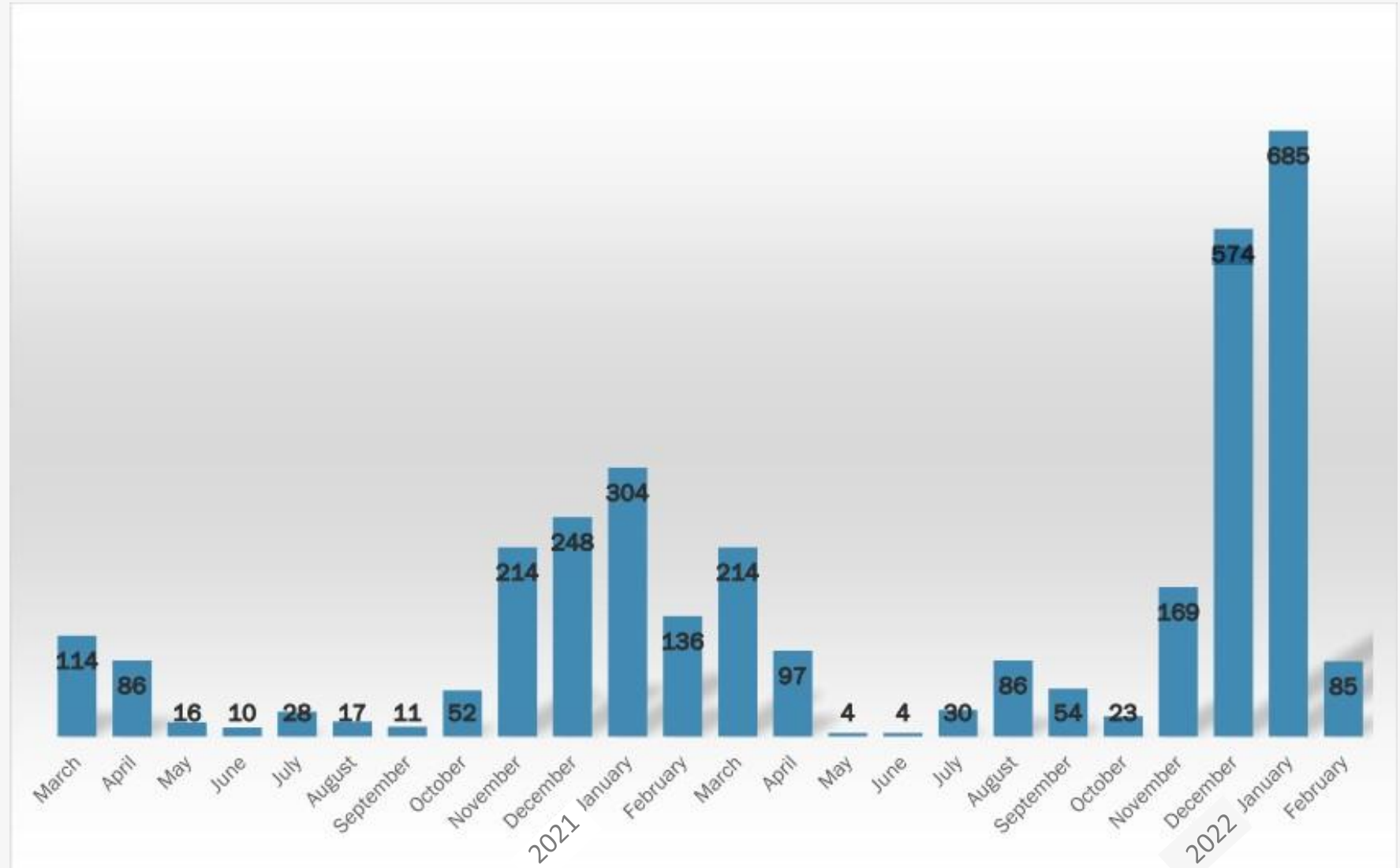

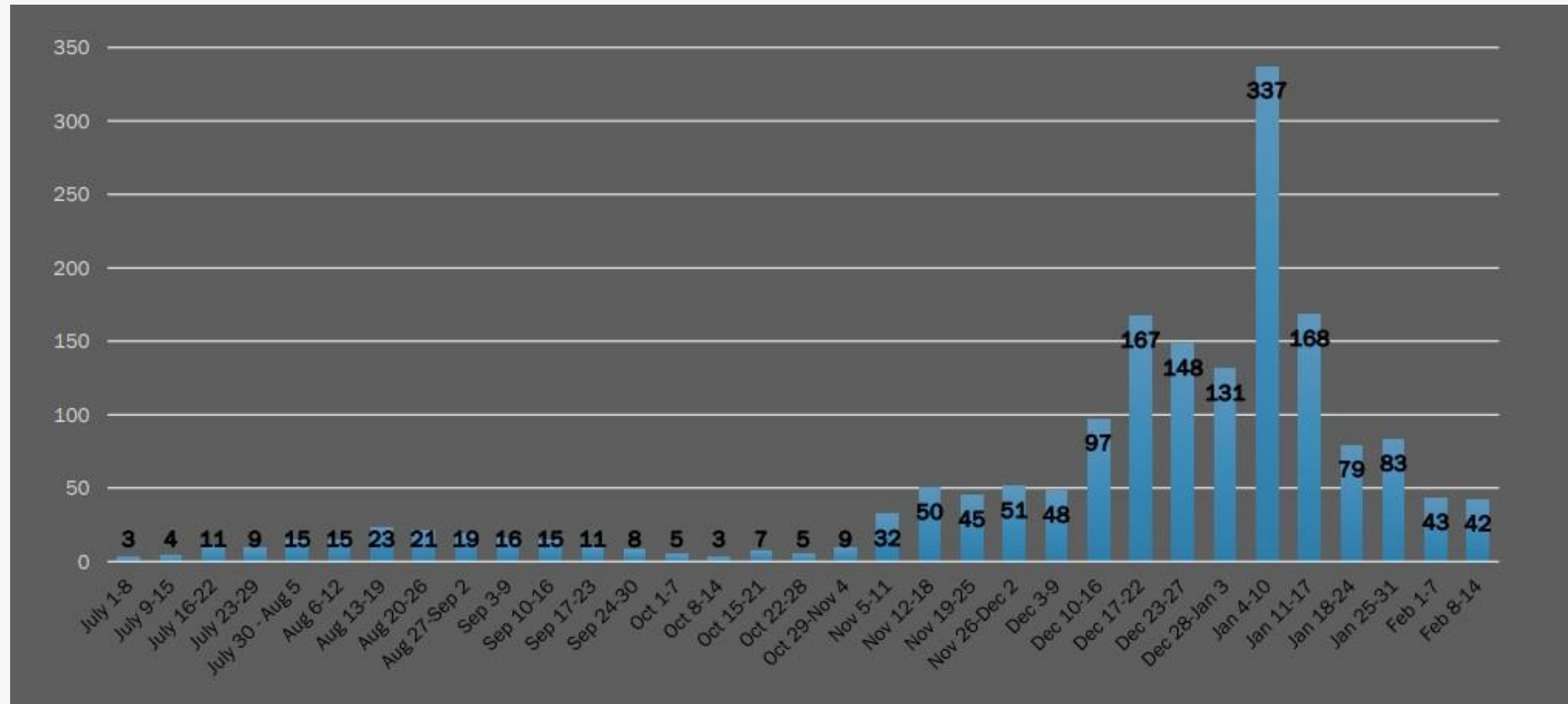

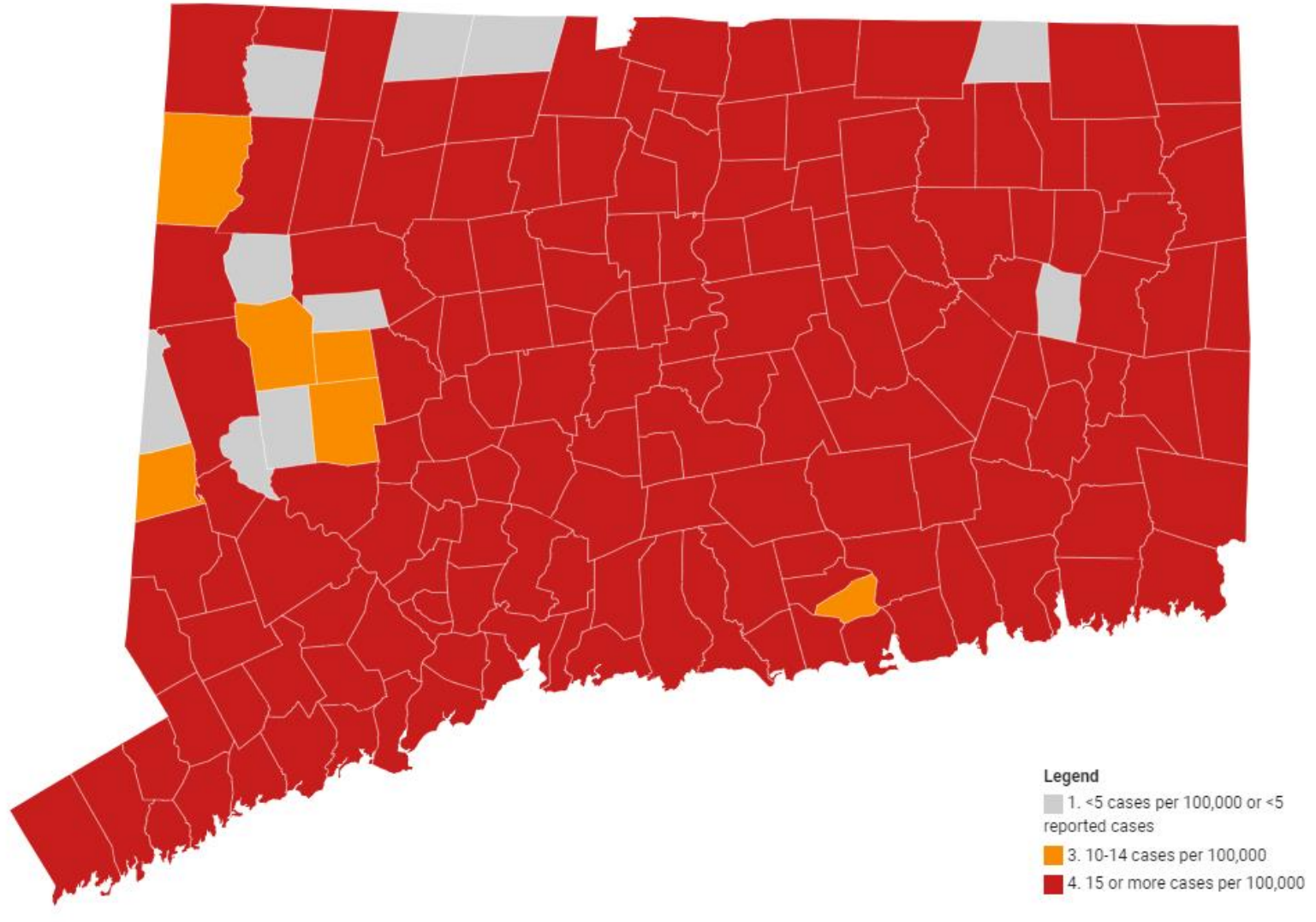

Mitigation Strategies (with optional mask wearing)

- Optional mask wearing PK-12
- No contact tracing
- Mask wearing on school buses
- Regular lunches
- Quarantining for COVID cases only
- COVID cases return to school on day 6 with mask; 10 days without
- Social distancing restrictions lifted (except during lunch for students who return from quarantine on day 6)
- Athletes return to school after 5 days (no medical note needed)
- SESS will work with families to address the needs of students with fragile medical conditions

- The District's Medical Team recommends mask wearing and the option for staff and students to choose.
- **Possible motion:** to adopt optional mask wearing effective Monday, February 28 for students, staff and visitors when on the grounds of Darien Public Schools.
