A. Policy – At the end of the second year, MS2 students are required to complete a comprehensive physical exam on a standardized patient and must achieve a score of 90% or better to demonstrate proficiency. Students that fail to achieve 90% are required to re-take the exam until they are able to demonstrate proficiency.

B. Purpose - Completion of this exam ensures that students are proficient in the minimum physical exam skills necessary for their clerkships.

C. Scope – This policy applies to all School of Medicine students

D. Procedure/Process – At the end of the second year, MS2 complete an objective structured clinical exam. Students are assessed on their physical exam skills through checklist items graded by Clinical Skills Center staff.
