KEY TAKEAWAYS

- 1** Nicholas Stec, student representative to the Board, presented several key updates about student activities. Highlights include Odyssey Fine Arts Week, which featured a full week of performances and events for students to enjoy during lunch periods and after school. The weeklong celebration of the arts was coordinated by the Fine Arts Division as well as the National Arts Honor Society.
- 2** The District is committed to making careful and thoughtful recommendations for renovations and maintenance/repairs in order to minimize the risk of more significant and costly facilities' issues in the future. Last night, the Board approved contract work for maintenance projects scheduled for this summer.

Other already approved maintenance projects for the summer include the installation of new perimeter lighting and code blue stations for public safety purposes. This brings the District's total sum for summer maintenance projects to \$5.8 million, far below the estimated \$7.1-7.5 million the District expected to spend.
- 3** The Board voted to approve a transportation contract for First Student for the 2022-23, 2023-24 and 2024-25 regular school years. This contract is different from previous years as it allows us to have a fleet of busses dedicated to driving routes that service solely our students. Currently, our bussing contract is tied with our feeder districts. This new contract allows for more timely transportation of our students to campus and home.
