### Early College Credit Opportunities

Why would anyone want to start college in high school? Why not? You are going to school anyway, why not save money, earn credits and accelerate time to graduation.

*\*Always check with the technical school, community college or university of your choice for specific criteria in a program or major, as not all institutions will recognize these credit options.*

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## What is PSEO?

- Opportunity for 10th, 11th, 12th grade Minnesota students to enroll and attend classes through a MN College/University off the high school campus.
- Full Time- All courses at PSEO-None at SAHS
- Part-Time- Enrolled in 1-5 courses at SAHS, 1-3 at PSEO
- 10th graders are limited to Career and Technical courses
- Many schools offer online courses - Student responsibility to structure time

# SAHS Registration

- Register at SAHS for a full 12 credit + 5 alternates
- After you apply, are accepted and register for your PSEO classes your SAHS schedule will be revised accordingly
- This schedule update usually occurs in August.

# College Credit vs. H.S. Credit

2 College Credits = 1 H.S. Credit

4 College Credits = 2 H.S. Credits

- All college courses are only one semester long
- PSEO grades/credits are NOT weighted on your SAHS transcript

## PSEO Application Process

1. Determine PSEO Institution(s) to apply to.
2. Use your chosen prospective PSEO school website as application guide.
3. Obtain, review, and sign SAHS PSEO agreement (from your counselor).
4. Plan a meeting with your SAHS Counselor about PSEO forms  
(Notice of student registration, credit requirement, etc) Do this Feb-May. Watch deadlines for colleges!



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## PSEO Application Process part 2

### 5. Schedule Placement test or gather test results

Refer to institution test requirement

### 6. Apply with All Application Paperwork to PSEO Institution

**\*NOTE** application deadline for some PSEO programs (ie: U of M - April 15)

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## PSEO Application Process part 3

7. Receive confirmation of acceptance from PSEO Institution
8. Attend PSEO orientation/meet with PSEO college advisor (April at Century or summer at other institutions)
9. Communicate your PSEO schedule with SAHS counselor to adjust your SAHS schedule to coordinate with PSEO schedule
10. Attend PSEO/SAHS classes! (August/September)



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
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## **Parchment steps to receive an unofficial view of transcript:**

### **Steps to update**

1. Log into your Parchment Account (you will need to create an account if you haven't already)
2. Click on the image of the transcript in the ordering tile under your high school.



3. Click the Update button that appears at the bottom of the transcript
  - o This will generate an order to your high school for a new free unofficial self-view transcript. Your high school will need to process this order before the updated version appears in your account.

**Again this is a free view of the unofficial transcript but will not be updated until the school has processed your request.**
