- NCAA mid-year transcript submission is complete. If you need a transcript for the NCAA, please complete a request and submit to your counselor. Official transcripts will be provided for mailing. Final transcript submission will take place mid-June.

## OUTDOOR TRACK AND FIELD TRYOUTS

All student-athletes who plan to try-out for the Girls & Boys Outdoor Track & Field Teams should pick up physical forms, emergency cards & Track Team paperwork outside of Room 257 on Main Street. We have sprint events, mid-distance & distance events, 5 field events (Shot Put, Discus, Long & Triple Jump and the High Jump), as well as 4 Relay events.

Athletes must register on North Point's Athletic website at <https://northpoint-ar.schooltoday.com> and upload an updated physical exam form (exam taken within the past 12 months), take the ImPact test (test only taken ONCE in 4 high school years), and check eligibility (NO failing grades during the 2nd marking period, less than 4.5 days of absences and a 2.25 or higher GPA). Select "Girls or Boys Varsity Outdoor Track" as your sport.

Practice begins on Tues, March 1 with practices from 3 to 5:30 PM.

# IF YOU TEST POSITIVE FOR COVID-19

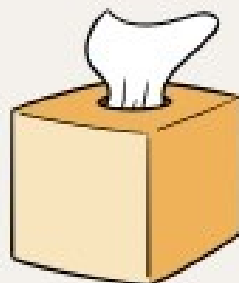
## WHERE TO START



- The date you take a COVID-19 test and it comes back positive but you have no symptoms.
- The date your COVID-19 symptoms start.

## IF YOU HAVE NO SYMPTOMS

If you are symptom-free on the fifth day after taking the test that came back positive or you have no COVID-19 symptoms on the morning of your fifth day after the onset of symptoms, you can return to work or school that day.



## IF YOU HAVE SYMPTOMS

If your symptoms are still present on Day 5, you must stay out of school or your work building for an additional five days.
