- **Aranza Guterriez!** Aranza is a star student for making a high grade on her fraction test! Way to go! ~A. Wilder



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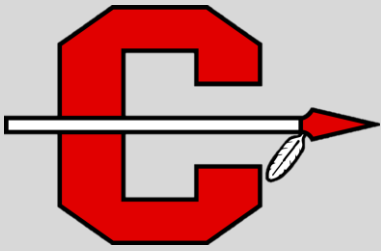
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Third Grade
