

Requirements for acceptance into Work Based Learning (WBL)

Requirements:

WBL student must:

- Be a junior or senior
- Be at least 16 years old
- Be on track for graduation.
- Provide own transportation to and from the job site.
- Have good attendance and discipline record.
- Have already earned at least one unit of credit in a CTAE course that is related to your job OR enroll in a related CTAE course for the upcoming year.
- Be well groomed.
- Have excellent work ethic (honest, dependable, punctual)
- Be willing to strictly follow school and work site dress code.
- Be able to take constructive criticism.
- Be willing to exhibit excellent behavior at school and on the work site.
- Have a job/internship.

Guidelines:

WBL student and parent understand that:

- Enrollment in the Work Based Learning Program can be for one or two years.
- Applying for the program does not guarantee that the student will automatically be accepted and acceptance does not mean job placement.
- Once accepted into the program, the student must sign a training agreement outlining responsibilities and obtain a work permit from the Board of Education.
