Literacy

We will be looking at texts containing Dinosaurs and Beasts. This will include Monstersaurus, Yucky Worms and Grendel. We will create wormeries from natural materials and learn about a worm's life.

We will be creating potions, inventions and monsters to support us to create some exciting

writing.





Maths

This term in maths we will be continuing to explore the concept of addition in a variety of ways using lots of different apparatus. We will explore capacity and use vocabulary such as full and empty, and length using the words long and short.

Later in the term we will begin to explore more formal ways of recording addition.



Phonics

We will continue to learn how to read and write using our phonic programme, The Sounds-Write reading programme. Please see Dear Parents for the sounds of the week that all Reception children will be learning.

Reading

Reading with your child everyday will help them become more familiar with their sounds and will improve their confidence blending them together. Children will bring home a book that closely matches their phonic knowledge, please support your child to read this as independently as possible. Bug Club also has a wide range of decodable texts that can further support individual reading. Please look out for the Bug icons, as these are questions to complete about the book.



World Book Day— Thursday 3rd March

We are asking that the children choose an animal from a favourite book that they may like to dress up as eg. The Very Hungry Caterpillar, the fox from the Gin-
