#### **ENGLISH**

#### **MATHS**


We will then revisit number and place value, ensuring we have a solid knowledge of the four operations which can be used to solve a variety of problems.



#### WIDER CURRICULUM FOCUS

Our Wider Curriculum theme for this term is 'Ocean Commotion'.

In Geography, we will begin by thinking about the planet that we live on and how this is divided into continents. We will then explore the different oceans, using maps, atlases and globes to secure our



Within science we will be building upon our knowledge of plants. We will be observing and describing how seeds and bulbs grow into mature plants. We will also find out and describe how plants need water, light and a suitable temperature to grow and stay healthy.

In Design and Technology this term, the children will create a moving picture book using levers and sliders.

In their RE lessons, the children will be learning all about Christianity and the creation story.

The children will be reading daily and developing their comprehension skills. This will include summarising, prediction and making inferences.
