

Dear Washington families,

Our students and staff have embarked on reading this year's *One Book One School* book, <u>Stella Diaz Has Something to Say</u>.

In this year's book, Stella, the main character, lives with her mother and brother in Chicago, Illinois. When Stella's best friend Jenny is in another class, Stella longs to make a new friend-maybe she could be friends with the new student who joined the class. But Stella is a little nervous to speak to people and in front of the class, especially when she accidentally speaks Spanish instead of English, which makes her turn *roja*.

In the first book of the *Stella Diaz* series, Stella shows that she definitely has something to say!

At home, we encourage you to ask your student about Stella, her family, and what character traits readers have learned about Stella and her family and friends. You can also discuss what challenges Stella is experiencing in the book (so far). The book is also rich in English and Spanish vocabulary, which the teachers review with their students.
