#### **Description**

Members will perform dances from genres of pom, lyrical, contemporary, jazz, and hip-hop. PCA Pom is an extension of spirit within the school. The director is Coach Jennifer Amburn and assistant director is Coach Ashlyn Lynch.

**Step 2:** Receive and review the audition material that will be sent to your email EOD Friday March 11. The material will be taught over video, which will allow your dancer to learn at the pace that best suits them.

\*\* Please note - There will be additional auditions throughout the year as needed for competitions, football games, pep rallies, and more. Buying a uniform and being in practice does not guarantee that you will perform. It will be a combination of the team member's work ethic, dance training, and academic/disciplinary good standing that will get them there.

**Managers:** Girls interested in manager need to email

<u>jamburn@prestonwoodchristian.org</u> to receive the manager virtual tryout requirements. They should be responsible, timely, organized, be able to seek out information online, and have the ability to create documents, spreadsheets, etc. Managers are responsible for music, costume sizing, videoing routines and more. They attend all events and fundraisers, help make everyone better behind the scenes, and are 100% a part of the team.

#### **Audition Attire:**

Team hopefuls should wear a black tank top (no midriff exposed) and black full-length leggings. Jazz shoes recommended, but tennis shoes will also work. Hair should be worn in a ponytail. No jewelry. Makeup is not required, but plan to look and feel your very best at auditions.

#### **Thursday Mock Audition Attire:**

Full-length leggings of any color (keep in mind PCA appropriateness) and a t-shirt. Jazz shoes recommended, but tennis shoes will also work.

#### Yearly Practice Schedule

PCA Pom will practice during 1<sup>st</sup> period, which meets on A Days. Unless otherwise notified by the director, practice begins at 8:30 AM on M, T, and F. Practice begins at 7:45 AM on W & Th. Practice will run both fall and spring. There will be a few additional evening/weekend practices for members to learn outside choreography and rehearse for competition and other performances. The team will have the opportunity to work with highly regarded choreographers as they prepare for competitions.

#### **Camp**

All members will be required to attend a two week summer camp leading up to the first week of school. Tentative dates are August 1-4<sup>th</sup> and August 8<sup>th</sup>-11<sup>th</sup> from 9am-12pm. The team will learn all of their contest, football and pep rally routines, attend technique and other classes, as well as work on leadership and teamwork skills. The biggest part of camp is the bonding!

#### **Fundraising & Service**

- Fall We will host a mini dance clinic on campus for LS students during football season likely on a Saturday in September. The entire team will work a 3-hour clinic on a Saturday morning and the mini-pom students will then perform their routine at the lower school night football game halftime.
- Spring We will host "Go College" on campus. This collegiate masterclass and solo workshop allows us to connect with schools in our area, showcase our talent, and fundraise.
- There will be an opportunity for the team to provide service to the community in the Spring/Fall.

#### Competition

PCA Pom will compete in multiple contests that take place between January and April. Most of these contests take place on the weekends and will involve the entire Saturday, if not some of Sunday. The team will be taking 3 team routines and 2 elite routines. Individuals are also permitted to take solos, duets, etc. upon receiving consent from the directors.
