² Most tenth graders will take Honors Algebra 2, with the majority of the remainder in Honors Geometry. See the separate document for further details on the high school mathematics curriculum.

³ Most tenth graders will take the course subsequent to their ninth grade class. This is the last year to begin a new language and still have that sequence meet graduation requirements. Students may, however, opt to begin a second language in addition to the sequence taken to meet graduation requirements.

⁴ Honors Chemistry is required to be completed by tenth grade, but AP Computer Science Principles, AP Computer Science A, AP Environmental Science, and Honors Anatomy & Physiology are available for tenth graders and higher, and all count for a full science credit toward graduation.
