Serving All Students

Pitcher is the only school in KCPS to specifically serve language-impaired students.

The Specific Language Impaired (SLI) program (formerly known as Delayed Language) is an alternative educational placement for children whose language acquisition and usage is significantly discrepant from the level expected for their age and cognitive ability. The program is designed to focus on language development, utilizing multiple techniques and materials to also help them progress through academic coursework. After receiving rigorous stimulation in language, reading, mathematics and social skills, most students progress into regular education placement by 4th grade with some level of SLI resource support.

One-to-One Digital Devices

Each student at Pitcher will receive his/her own digital device in the classroom. This device can house student materials, textbooks, and help increase digital literacy.
