HISTORY OF J.A. ROGERS Celebrating Culture

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The school was named after Joel Augustus Rogers (September 6, 1880 – March 26, 1966), an African-American author, journalist and historian. He contributed to the history of Africa as well as to the history of African-Americans in the United States.

His academic fields encompassed history, sociology and anthropology. By challenging existing ideas about race, and revealing the connections between civilizations, he became a legendary figure in the promotion of the knowledge of African history in the 20th century.
